Wednesday, 14 May 2025 Who Am I? I Am Skin Cancer!

Marion Patrick (one of our Vice Presidents) will be our Guest Speaker at our May meeting.

Past sun exposure increases our skin cancer risk as we age. Understand your personal risk and the different types of skin cancer.

In 2004 Marion jointly setup and owned the 1st National Mobile Workplace Skin Cancer Clinic. The Company introduced the 1st Dermatology

telehealth platform into Australia enabling Dermatologist diagnostic opinion of lesions added to that of the examining doctors. The aim of the practice was to increase both the awareness and the early detection of skin cancer thereby minimizing skin cancer related morbidity. Full body skin examinations and early detection of lesions was only part of the process – Skin cancer awareness and prevention education was essential.

Over a period of 17 years Marion provided Skin Cancer Awareness and Health seminars to workplaces throughout Australia.

The Mathema Gallery, Mt Mee

The Mathema Museum, situated in the beautiful countryside around Mt Mee, founded by mathematicians Dr Calvin Irons (University of Iowa Graduate) and his wife Rosemary, is home to an amazing collection of Mathematical Artefacts, from all ages and countries.



On display are exhibits, books, texts and illustrations, demonstrating Maths through history - from Ancient Babylonia, Egypt and China, The Mayan and Incan civilisations through to 2025.

See how maths and its application play such a central role in everyday lives.

The Museum is air conditioned, and comfortable to walk through. There is a gift shop of difference on site.
